

THE ROCKET BAG

The Rocket Bag is a Bill Amberg icon. Originally developed in 1990, it has become a classic of both design and leathercraft, entering the V&A Museum's permanent archive in 2001, as well as the collection of the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York. The piece is Bill's modern interpretation of a traditional briefcase design, with smooth, fluid curves inspired by the classic rocket silhouette. Its aesthetic impact is enhanced by the ancient-meets-modern material contrast between traditional bridle leather and machined aluminium.



The Options

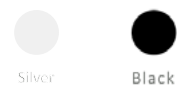
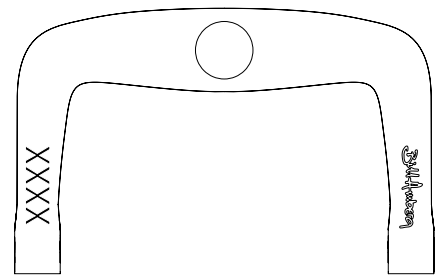
To make your custom Rocket bag, select from your choice of aniline dyed vegetable tanned leather for the exterior.

The interior can be done in your choice of suede in beige, charcoal, or red, or add that extra touch of luxury with beige or cobalt lambskin (+£150)

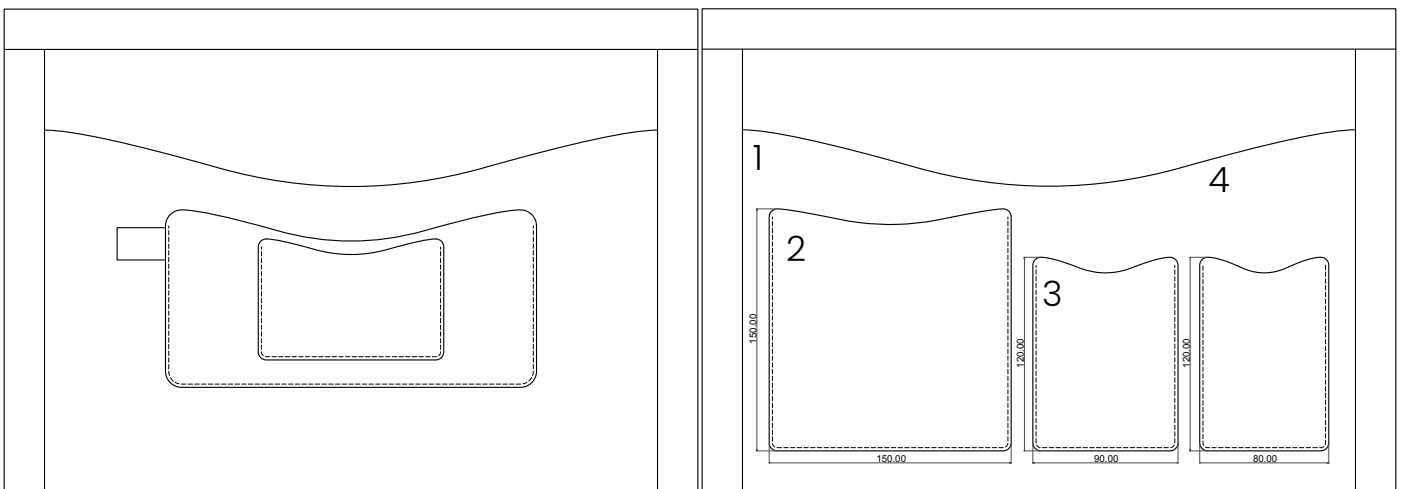


The Handle

The solid aluminium handle now comes in 2 finishes, classic polished silver or matte black. Personalise your handle with up to 4 characters of engraving.



The Pockets



SIDE A
One large pocket for documents or a laptop, a smaller pocket, card holder, and pen loop. This pocket arrangement comes standard in all Rocket bags.

SIDE B
1. Large pocket comes standard with all Rocket bags
2. Small tablet pocket (+£150)
3. Passport pocket (+£150)
4. Sunglasses pocket (+£150)
